Cecchetti Classical Ballet Grades

The table below provides information regarding rules on exam timings and the number of candidates that can entered per set for examinations.

Please note that exam candidates should be entered in sets of 4 from Grade 1 to Grade 6 - unless there are insufficient numbers, in which case groups of 3, 2 or just 1 candidate may be entered. Where there are an odd number of candidates, the extra candidates should be entered with a pair, making a group of three. Exceptions re. numbers of candidates in an exam can be made in some circumstances. For example, if the size of an exam venue prohibits larger groups.

Option 1 / Option 2 candidates can be entered together.

Class Examinations and Senior Certificates 1 & 2

Teachers are expected to conduct the work for the children in the examination room from Pre-Primary to Class Exam 6. The order of the syllabus should be reasonably adhered to.

Senior Certificates 1 and 2 are conducted by the examiner. The teacher is not present.

Every child must have their timetable number pinned to their uniform.

Teachers should note that these time allowances include a five-minute writing period for the examiner therefore the syllabus demonstration must be completed five minutes before the time allowance given for Pre-Primary to Class Exam 6.

Pre-Primary

- The minimum number of candidates is 2, maximum is 5.

Primary, Standards 1 - 6

- The minimum number of candidates is one and the maximum is five the ideal number of candidates is four.
- Under no circumstances should mature candidates be entered with teenagers.
- If there are more than four candidates, the recommendations are as follows;

Senior Certificate 1 & 2

- The maximum number of candidates per set is three.

Minimum Ages

Minimum age specifications are to ensure that the candidates are physically developed sufficiently to safely meet the demands of the syllabus. All minimum ages specified are the age at the date of the examination less 60 days.

Minimum age limits do not indicate that a candidate will be ready to take the examination at that age and it is the responsibility of the teacher to assess the physical, cognitive and artistic development of the candidate to meet the requirements of the syllabus, with particular regard to safe dance practice.

There is no upper age limit.

All levels are conducted by the examiner. The teacher is not present in the examination room.

Minimum Ages

Minimum age specifications are to ensure that the candidates are physically developed sufficiently to safely meet the demands of the syllabus. All minimum ages specified are the age at the date of the examination less 60 days.

Minimum age limits do not indicate that a candidate will be ready to take the examination at that age and it is the responsibility of the teacher to assess the physical, cognitive and artistic development of the candidate to meet the requirements of the syllabus, with particular regard to safe dance practice.

There is no upper age limit.

Cecchetti Classical Ballet Vocational Exams

Candidates taking Intermediate Foundation and above should be scheduled at the start of the examining day where possible.

Candidates should be entered in pairs except when there is an odd number, a group of three may be entered in Intermediate Foundation and Intermediate only.

Vocational Graded Exams All Levels - those entering the Option 1 syllabus (formerly Female) and those entering Option 2 (formerly Male syllabus) may not be examined together. If they wish to show different options, they must be entered separately.
